- **PICTURE TALK**

The topic "My Grandfather and my Grandmother" was held on 2nd February. The teacher spoke about the topic by showing the pictures and emphasizing on the new words. The aim was to help the children connect with the picture and express about it.

- **GERMINATION OF A SEED ACTIVITY**

The activity was conducted on 11th February. Teacher sowed the seeds in disposable container. The teacher explained the process how a seed grows into a plant. The process of sowing and watering was demonstrated and with the virtual guidance of teacher, children performed the task. The children watered their seeds. - **NAME OF FLOWERS ACTIVITY**

Name of flowers- activity was conducted by Mrs. Ranjeeta Ingleshwar on 18th February. The children were shown pictures of flowers with their names and asked to write the names in their EVS notebooks. This will enable children to identify and name common flowers.

- **PAPER FOLDING FAN ACTIVITY**

This activity was carried out on 18th February by Mrs Rizwana. The teacher teaches a simple way to fold paper and make it into a fan. This activity helps in improving Fine Motor Skills and Eye- Hand coordination.

- **CCA- TALENT HUNT ACTIVITY**

The school conducted Talent Hunt competition on 24th February where in the child performed along with one family member in any activity of their choice like singing, dancing, skit, puppet show, playing musical instrument, No fire cooking, painting etc. This event was first of its kind in the school curriculum and saw enthusiastic participation. The creativity and confidence of the participants was very much evident and the event was a huge success.

- **CLASS WEBINAR**

Kindergarteners not only miss their school but their friends too so, webinars are being conducted on all Saturdays to interact and revise academics with full class. - **PUBLIC SPEAKING**

The aim was to improve vocabulary and develop communication skills.

UKG

- **CONVERSATIONAL SKILLS**

LKG

A conversation skill on the topic "Telephone conversation" was held on 22nd February. The teacher explained how to politely and safely answer phone calls .She also explained how to converse with each other on the phone. The aim was to nurture their communication skills and develop vocabulary.

UKG

Conversation skills on the topic "Picnic at the beach" was conducted by Mrs. Ranjeeta Ingleshwar on 10th February. The children were told about the do's and don'ts when on the beach. The objective being to teach them makes simple and complete sentences and inculcates habit of cleanliness among them.

- **STORY TELLING**
