ACTIVITY REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER 2019

➤ **SPECIAL ASSEMBLY – GANDHI JAYANTI**

A special Assembly was conducted on 1st October to commemorate the 150th birth anniversary of our Father of the Nation – Mahatma Gandhi. The assembly started with speech by children who spoke about Gandhi ji and his contribution towards Indian freedom movement. The programme included a prayer, depiction of three important revolutions started by Gandhi ji during Indian freedom movement namely, Non-cooperation movement, Dandi march, Quit india movement. The programme concluded with a foot tapping dance number and a vote of thanks.

The assembly was conducted under the guidance of Mrs. Samyukta.

➤ **GROUP ACTIVITY: DECORATION OF RAVAN CUT OUT : LKG & UKG**

Group Activity on decorating Ravana cut out was conducted for LKG and UKG classes on 1st October as part of forthcoming Dusshera festival. It was a structured activity in which the children were first told about the great fight between Rama and Ravana and then Activity teachers guided children to decorate the cut out.

➤ **DUSHERA SPECIAL MORNING AND BURNING OF RAVANA:**

Dusshera Special morning assembly was celebrated on 3rd October for LKG and UKG classes to teach children about the victory of good over evil. Students enacted the story to narrate God Rama's Vanvas, kidnapping of Sita by Ravana and eventually victory of Rama over Ravana. Ravana's effigy was burnt to symbolize 'victory of good over evil' which was followed by a colourful dandiya performance by HM and teachers.

This special morning was also witnessed by Primary wing. Dusshera Special morning assembly was concluded by Headmistress interacting with the children to reinforce the story and moral behind Dusshera celebration.

➤ **PTI MEETING : LKG AND UKG**

The First Mid - Term PTI was held on 4th October to keep the parents abreast of their wards' progress. Report cards were also shown to the parents. HM Mrs. Swati Adak took rounds of the school and interacted with parents.

➤ **GROUP ACTIVITY:COLLAGE OF ANIMALS: UKG**

A structured Activity was conducted on 15th October for UKG children on making collage of animals. Children were taught about Wild animals and domestic animals by respective Class Teachers. Children identified cut outs of domestic animals and wild animals and pasted them on Activity chart paper to complete the collage.
