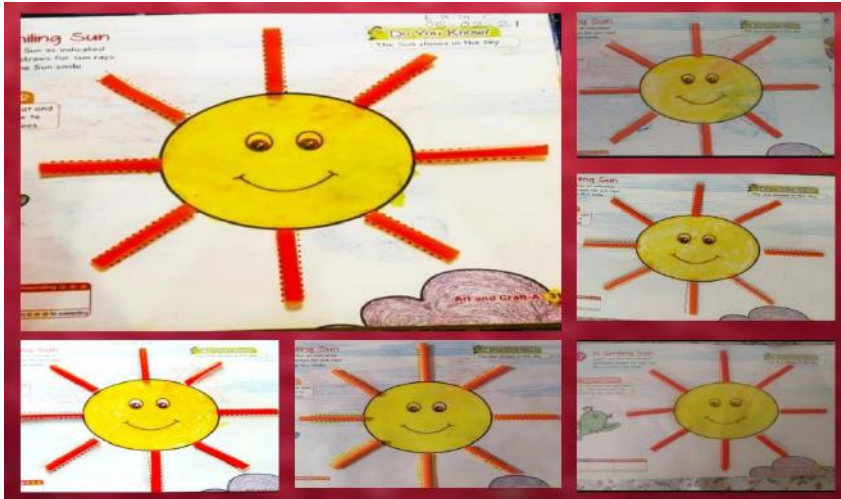


THE SMILING SUN

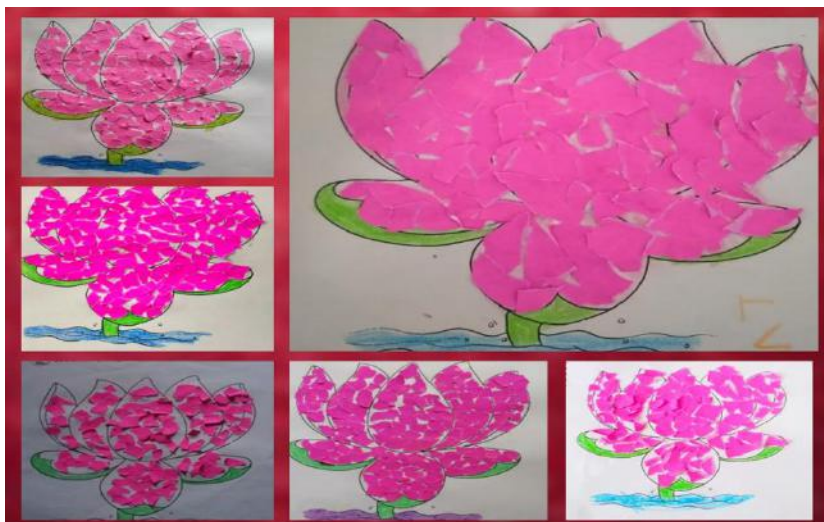


TEARING & PASTING- LOTUS FLOWER

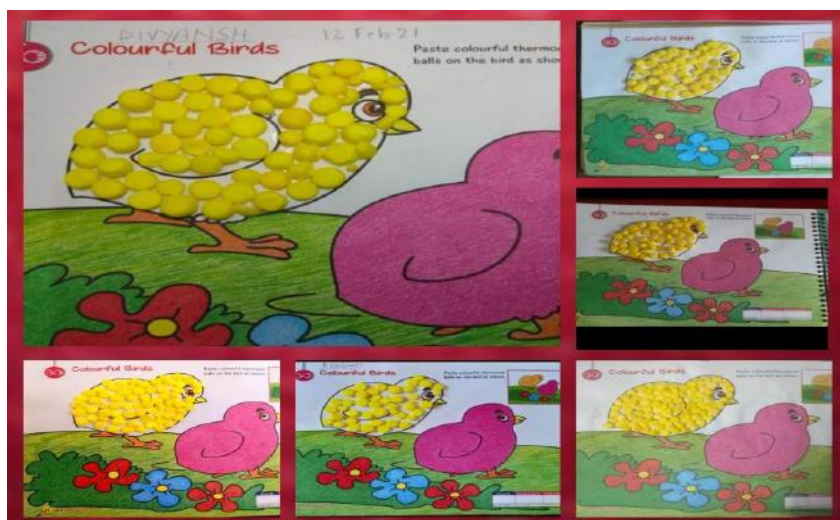


COLOURFUL BIRDS-PASTING THERMOCOL BALLS

GERMINATION ACTIVITY(UKG)

Planting and watching seeds growing into a Plant is a wonderful experience for children. In which children have used materials Tin, Soil, Water, Sunlight and some Seeds. Where they will come to know that these things help a seed to grow into a sapling and then into a tree or a plant.

To explain this activity a video was posted to all the UKG class groups of NKG NSB on 5th February 2021. The teacher in charge Mrs Rachel Seth demonstrated the activity step by step. The class teachers too explained the Germination activity during the Teacher-Student Interaction on 5th February 2021. The children were asked to do the activity at home along with their parents and share the pictures (while doing the activity & after a week when the seeds grow into a Saplings) in their respective class groups.



SPRAY PAINTING(UKG)

Painting helps children develop their fine motor skills & decision-making skills. They need to plan ahead as to which colour should be used for different parts of the painting. Painting can help children learn sizes, shapes, patterns and designs. These are all critical aspects of their curriculum during pre-school years. Painting aids children acquire hand-eye coordination, an important skill in their age. This is developed while they learn to paint the parts that they see; making sure their hand movement is at par with their vision.

In order to teach spray painting a video was posted to in all UKG Class Groups of NKG NSB on 16th February 2021. The teacher in charge demonstrated the activity step by step. Later children were asked to complete the activity under the supervision of their parents and share their beautiful painting pictures in their respective class groups.

TEACHER STUDENT INTERACTION

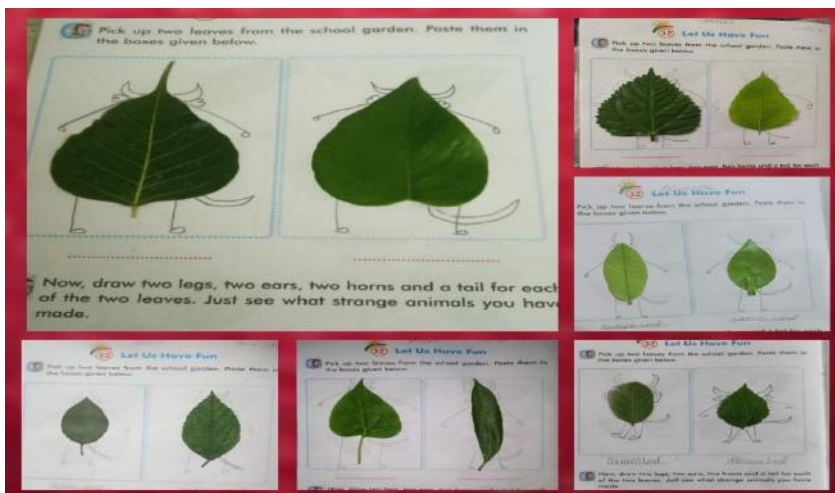

Later children completed the activity under the supervision of parents and shared the pictures of their beautiful origami fan in their respective class groups.



GRATITUDE CARD (LKG)

The definition of gratitude is the quality or feeling of being grateful or thankful for eg gratitude is how someone would feel if their friend or any unknown person does something exceptionally nice for them, it may be in their school like Amma or security guard etc.

The basic idea is to explain children that why do we say thank you to people who help us. In view of the same a video was posted in all LKG class groups of NSB on 25th February 2021.
