- **SPECIAL ASSEMBLY- NAVY DAY**

Navy Day is dedicated towards commemorating the vigor and valor of Naval personnel and to remind the citizens to care for the living heroes who are either serving or retired from service. Keeping its tradition, to acknowledge and appreciate the sacrifices made by our soldiers, the students of LKG-N celebrated this remarkable day on the 4th December by holding a special assembly. The assembly started with tiny tots dressed in uniform wishing Navy Day to the servicemen leaving to office early morning, followed by march past in the premises. The students spoke about the significance of this day and the role of our forces in guarding and defending our country against all odds.

- **ANNUAL DAY- GURUCOOL**

Naval Kindergarten School, Dolphin Hill, Visakhapatnam hosted their Annual Day for the year 2019-20 on 12th December 2019 themed “**GuruCool – Shiksha se Badhkar**” with vibrancy and life being propelled into magnificent and reverberating celebrations at INS Eksila auditorium. - **GROUP ACTIVITY - COLLAGE OF ANIMALS**

A group activity was conducted on 16th December for LKG students to make a collage of animals. Before the activity, respective teachers helped the children differentiate between various wild animals, domestic animals, water animals and birds. The children identified cut-outs of different types of animals and pasted them on the activity chart paper to complete the collage.

- **FIRE AND EVACUATION DRILL**

A mock fire and evacuation drill was conducted at our School, on 17th December, to create awareness among students to respond swiftly in times of emergency. The responsible teachers and staff were positioned at the key areas to guide and assist the students in the mock fire and evacuation drill.

The 'evacuation' operation began moments after the fire alarm rang out loud and alerted everyone. The students immediately evacuated their classrooms.
