
• GERMINATION OF SEED ACTIVITY


• LEAF PRINTING ACTIVITY

The strength for each slot is 10 children so that teacher can give one to one attention. The students participate in the webinar very enthusiastically. It brings all the students on an equal footing.



• MUSIC WEBINAR

Music webinar is conducted twice in a week.i.e. On Thursday for LKG students and Friday for UKG students. This webinar is extremely enjoyable and interactive session where children were excited to see their music teacher playing music and singing the rhymes along with actions .All the students participate in the webinar very enthusiastically. Music teacher gives individual attention .She stimulates, facilitate and encourage the students to repeat the rhymes .This webinar allows for better interaction with children in ways that promote learning and development.



• <u>TELEPHONIC VIDEO CALLS</u>

Individual WhatsApp video calls are taken for UKG children every week in order to strengthen the reading skills as well as concept clearing.' All children are divided in three slots in three days so that ample time can be given to each individual child. Feedback obtain from parents indicates this video calling practice is highly beneficial and appreciated.



• PEACOCK HAND PRINTING ACTIVITY

Peacock handprint was conducted on 23rd July through video. First teacher has given demonstration step by step and told children to follow the same. It enhanced the learning and eye hand coordination of children.



• PLAY AND LEARN

<u>LKG</u>

Play and learn activity was conducted on 17th July. The children were very excited to do this activity, by rolling the dice on the floor and on whichever shape the dice lands on, they had to jump. This activity helps to identify and connect to the particular shape. This activity also improves gross motor skills and eye and body coordination.

The objective of this activity was to collaborate learning and fun together. This activity helped children to learn in a play way method. 
• UKG
