2. TEACHER'S DAY CELEBRATIONS





3. FRIDAY STUDENT TEACHER INTERACTION - LKG



The session was conducted smoothly.


5. GRANDPARENTS DAY CARD MAKING ACTIVITY

For 'e' vowel revision, picture was shown on sletter and read the word.


After the academic revision a fun filled scave session lively and interesting for students. In were asked to find out something that:
