


• STOCKING MAKING ACTIVITY

• PUBLIC SPEAKING

LKG

Public speaking was held on 10th December on the topic "Visit to the zoo". The teacher explained how animals are kept and taken care in the zoo so that we can see them from close and learn about them. The teacher taught few lines about the topic and children were encouraged to repeat after her. The aim was to improve vocabulary and develop communication skills.

UKG

Public Speaking on the topic "Winter Season" was conducted on 15th December. Public speaking enhances oral skills of a child and develops self-confidence and self-esteem. To attain the objective, children were given practice by teacher to speak few lines about Winter Season in front of peers.



• CLASS WEBINAR

Academic webinars are conducted by the school five days a week for LKG and UKG. All the topics from daily split up are taught in the webinars. It gives children the experience of class room during online studies.



• MUSIC WEBINAR

Music webinar is conducted twice in a week i.e. on Thursday for LKG students and Friday for UKG students. This webinar is extremely enjoyable and interactive session where children were excited to see their music teacher playing music and singing the rhymes along with actions. All the students participate in the webinar very enthusiastically. Music teacher gives individual attention .She stimulates, facilitate and encourage the students to repeat the rhymes .This webinar allows for better interaction with children in ways that promote learning and development.



• PLAY AND LEARN ACTIVITIES

<u>ACTIVITY 1 – SORTING OUT WITH PHONIC SOUND</u>

Play and Learn activity on "sorting out with phonic sound" was conducted for LKG on 3rd December. In this activity alphabets from V to Z were arranged in one side. Then out of a pile an object was picked and put in front of the alphabet whose phonic sound matched with the first sound of the name of the object. The aim was to make the children be familiar with the phonic sound of the alphabets.





ACTIVITY 2 - FINGERPRINT CATERPILLAR COUNTING

Fingerprint Caterpillar Counting was done on 10th December as a part of play and learn activity which incorporated art and craft with learning to count numbers up to 10. Being a hands-on activity, it also aimed at developing fine motor skills of KG students.





ACTIVITY 3 - PLAY AND LEARN- THIS/THAT

Play and learn Activity was conducted on 10th December. Children were guided to do observe, speak run and put objects in the relevant box, while revising the concept of 'this/that. The objective of this activity was to collaborate learning and fun together. This activity helped children to learn in a play way method. It also improves hand eye coordination and gross motor skills of children.

ACTIVITY 5 - JUMP, WALK AND HOP WITH "U" FAMILY

Play and Learn Activity was conducted for UKG on 3rd Dec on "Jump, Walk & Hop with 'u' Vowel Family". In this activity there were 3 shapes from start point where children have to jump, walk and hop till finish point in which throughout the route there was placards of words and the pictures were placed randomly. The child needs to do the following activity as per the given instructions from first shape starting point with the basket of placards related to those which was already placed. Children have to identify the placard and picks up the right placard from the basket and places next to the placard which was already arranged. This activity will go on till the finish point. The aim was to make the children identify the words as well as the pictures of the 'u' Vowel Family.



• NAME OF WATER ANIMALS

This activity was done on 10th December. The children were told that water animals are animals that live in water. They were also shown pictures of water animals and told their names. They then wrote the name of these water animals in their EVS notebook. The objective of this activity was to enable them to recognize water animals and name them. This also enhanced their vocabulary and general knowledge.

CONVERSATION SKILLS

LKG

Conversation skills on the topic "Caring for Animals" was held on 14th December .The teacher explained to the children that we should be caring towards animals. She also explained how to converse with each other. The aim was to nurture their communication skills and develop vocabulary.

UKG

Conversation skills play an important role in holistic development of a child. It enhances oral skills, vocabulary, pronunciation and confidence of the child. To attain the objective conversation skills was taken virtually on the topic "Helpers" on 21st December.

STORY

LKG

The Story telling Activity was held on 20th December. The story "The Two Silly Goats" was generated with the help of props. The activity aimed at improving the children's listening ability and vocabulary.
