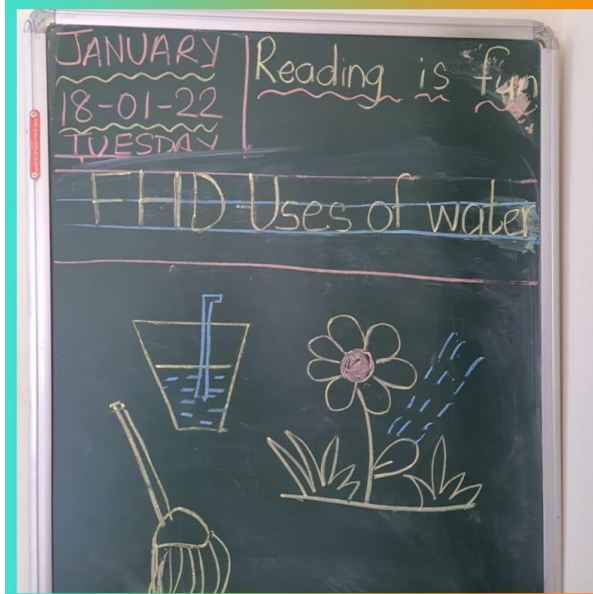
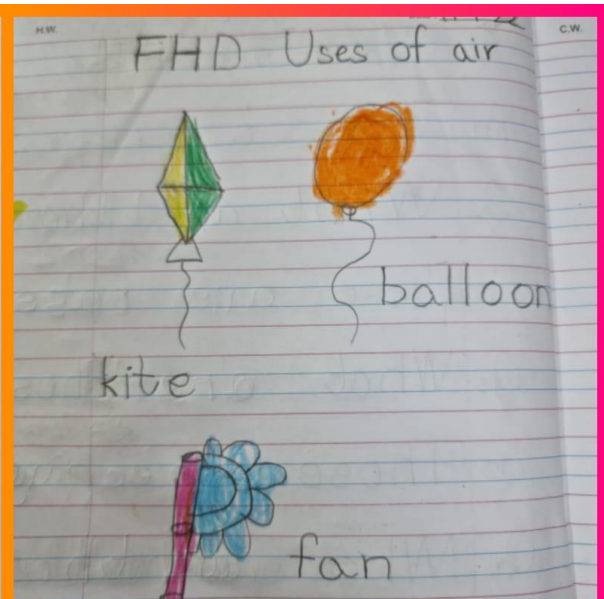
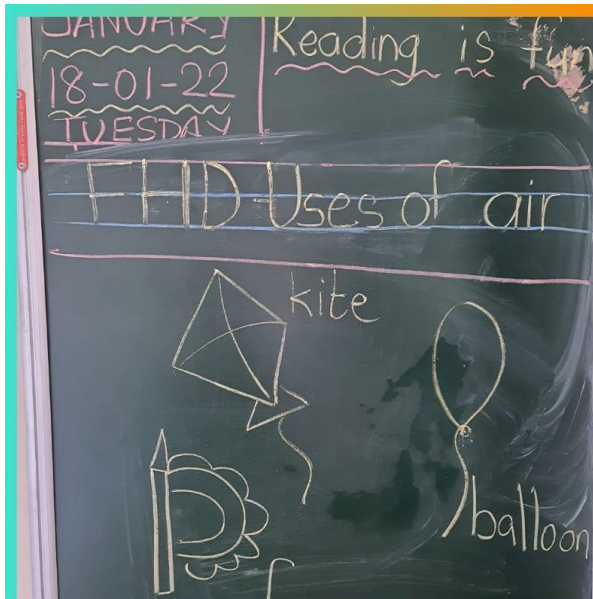
- **MAKAR SANKRANTI SPECIAL ASSEMBLY**

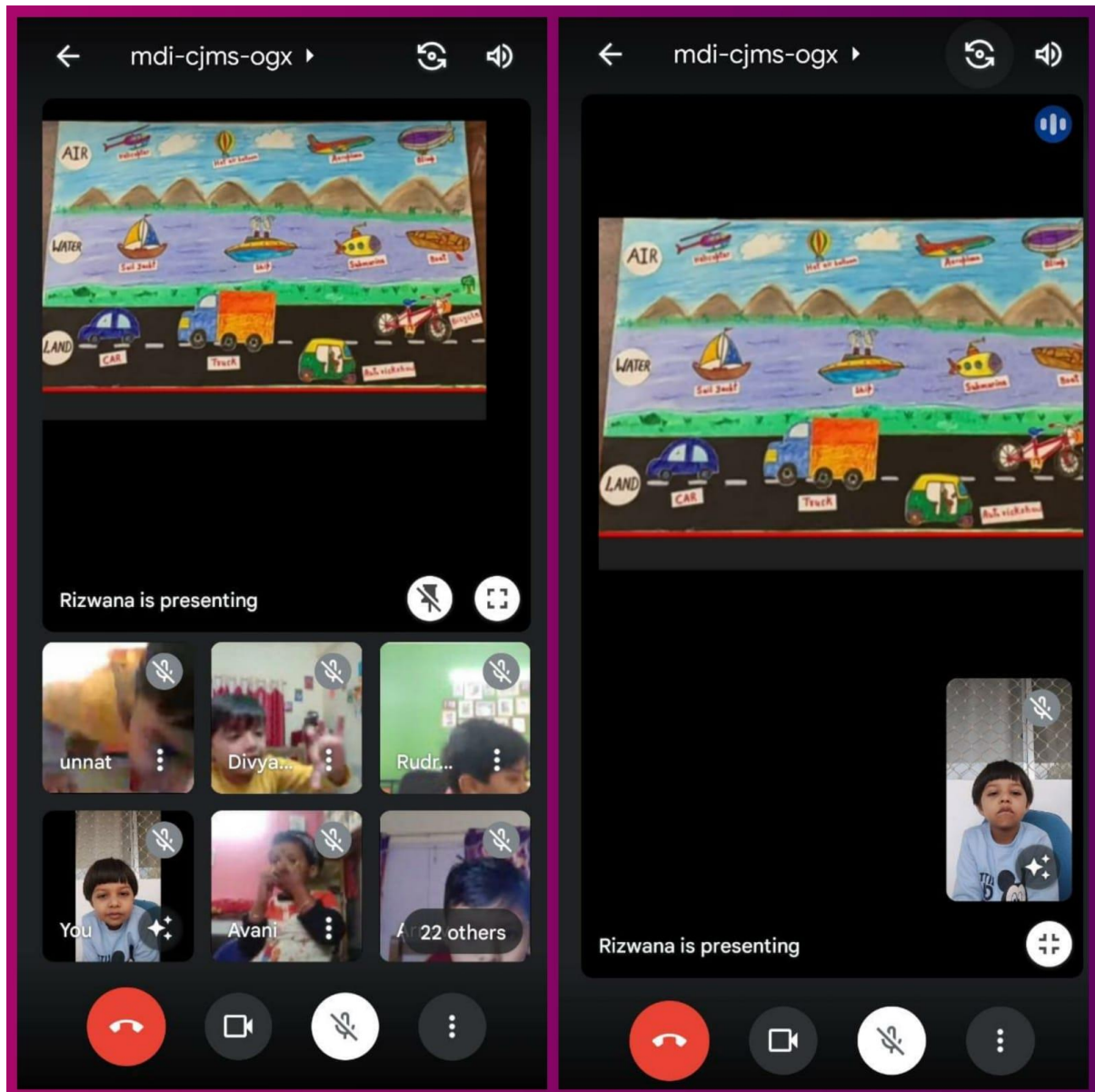
- **FHD – AIR AND WATER**

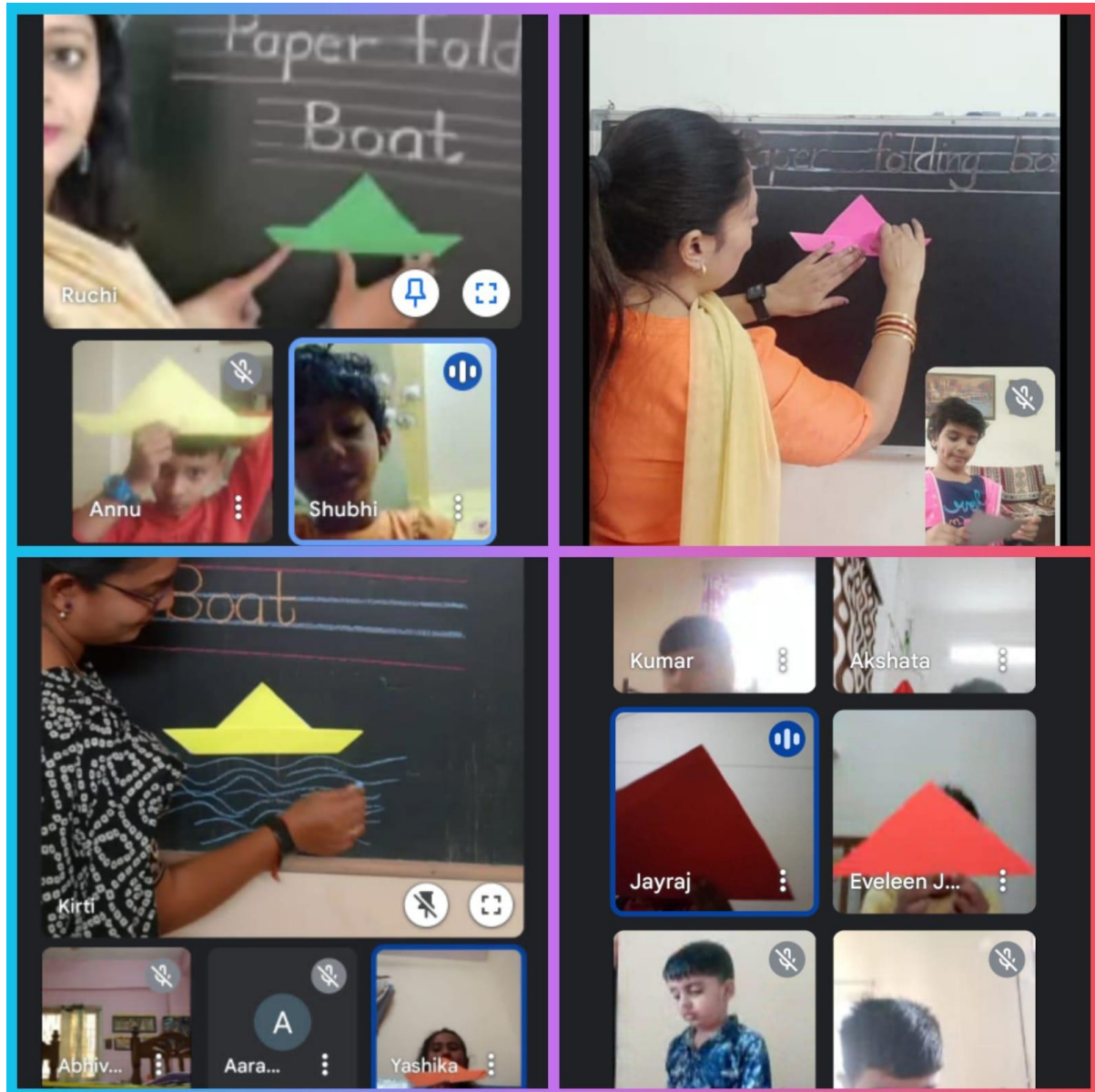
- **COLLAGE MAKING ACTIVITY**

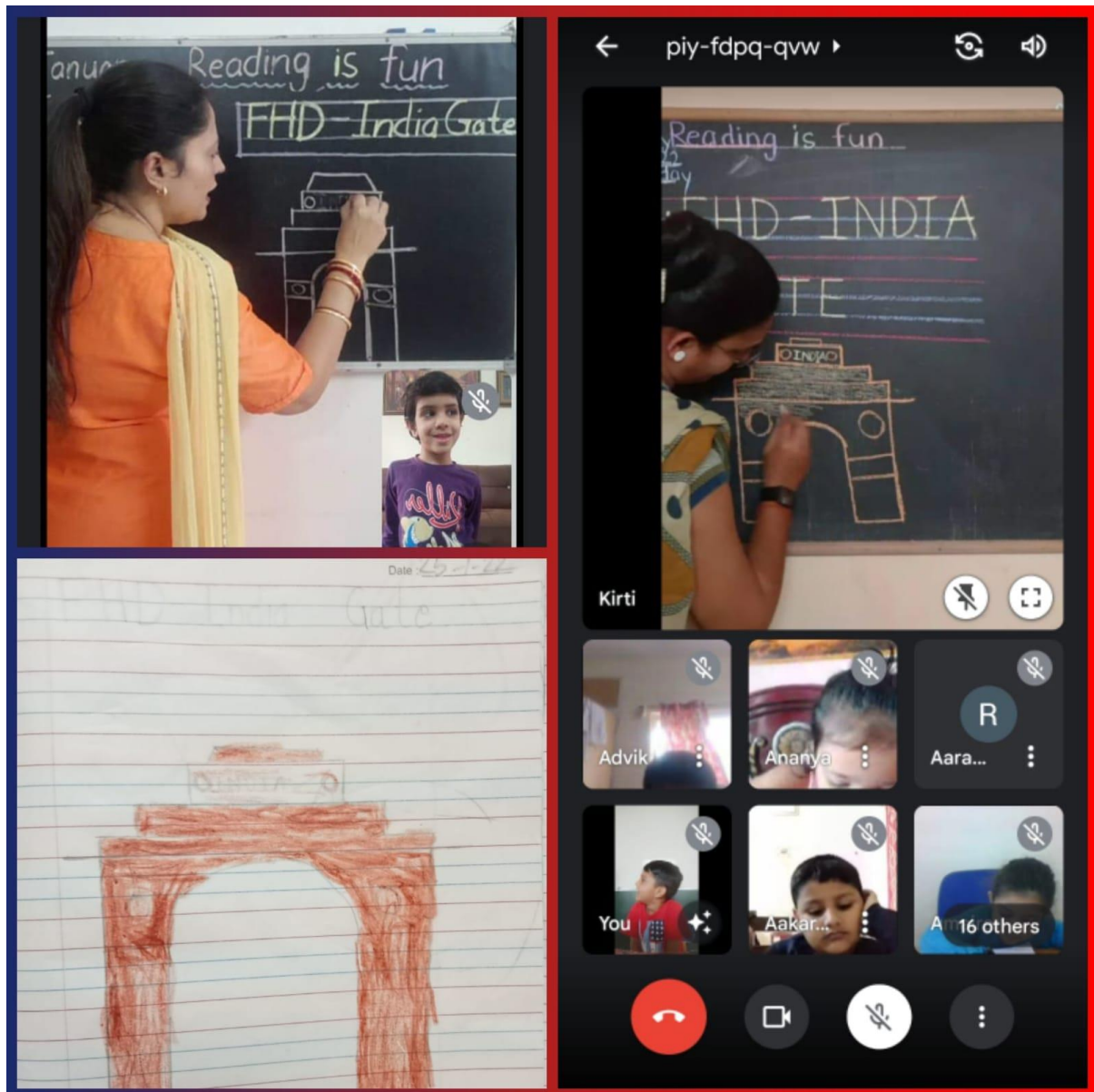
- **REPUBLIC DAY GROUP ACTIVITY**

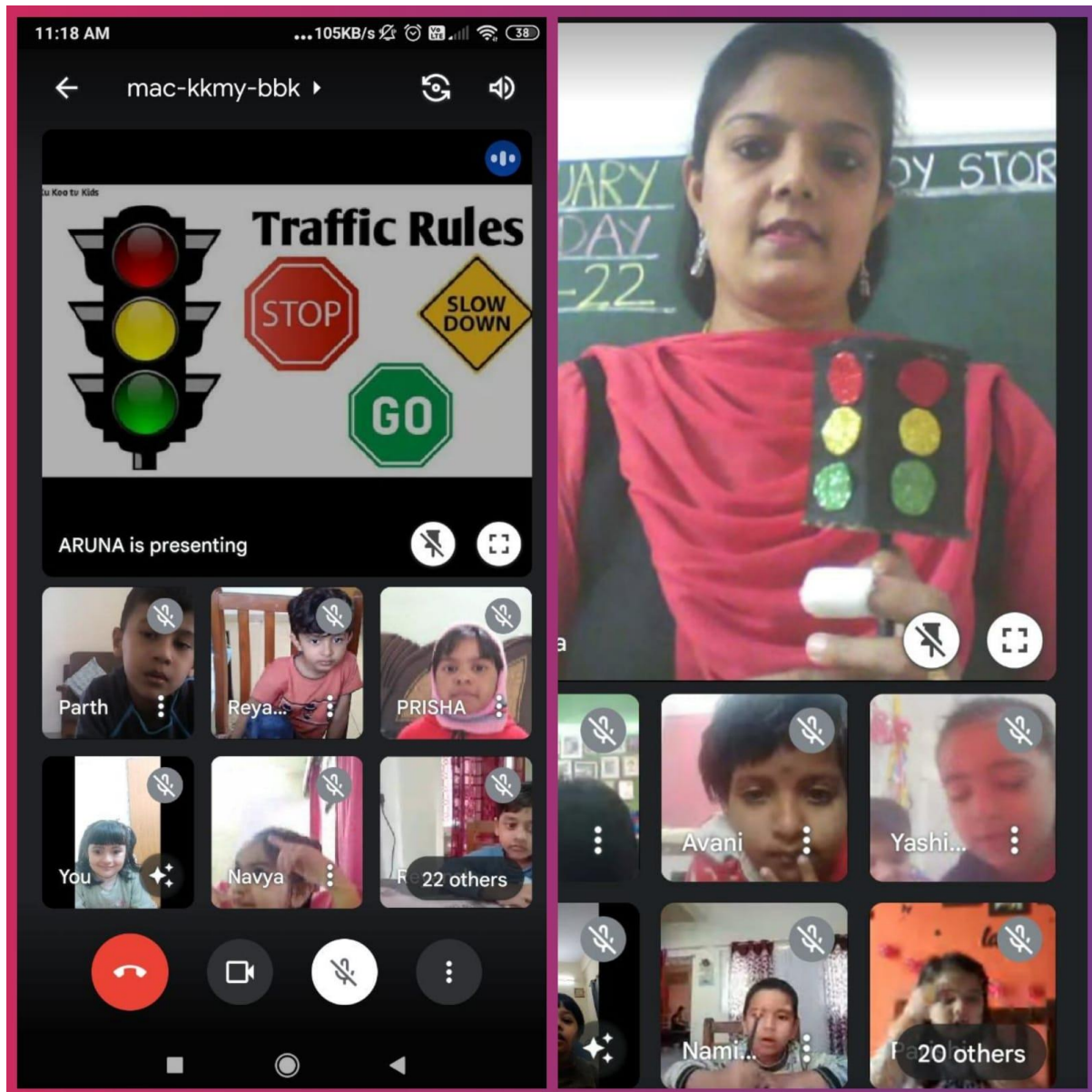
- **REPUBLIC DAY SPECIAL ASSEMBLY**

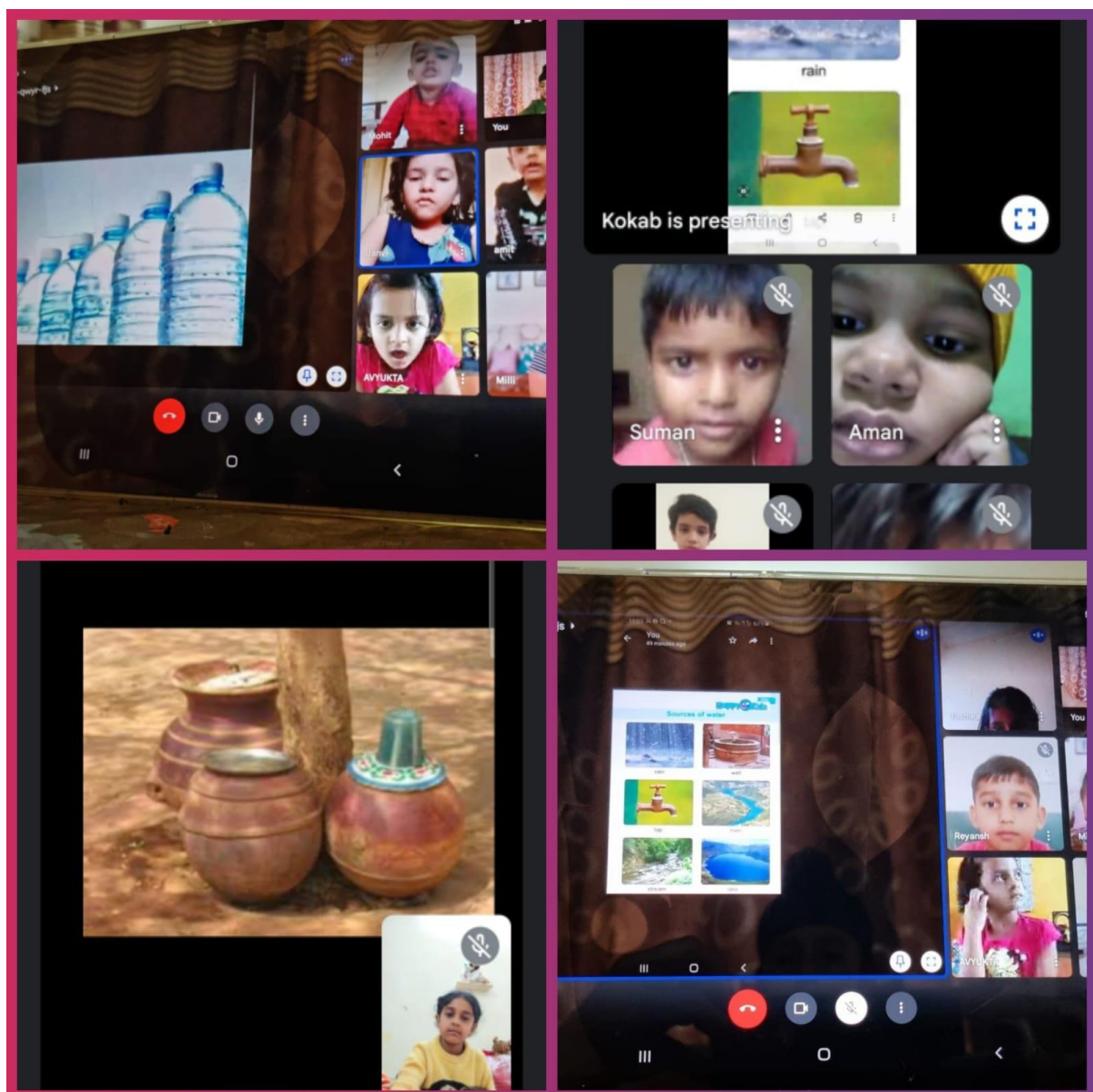
- **CONVERSATION SKILLS**

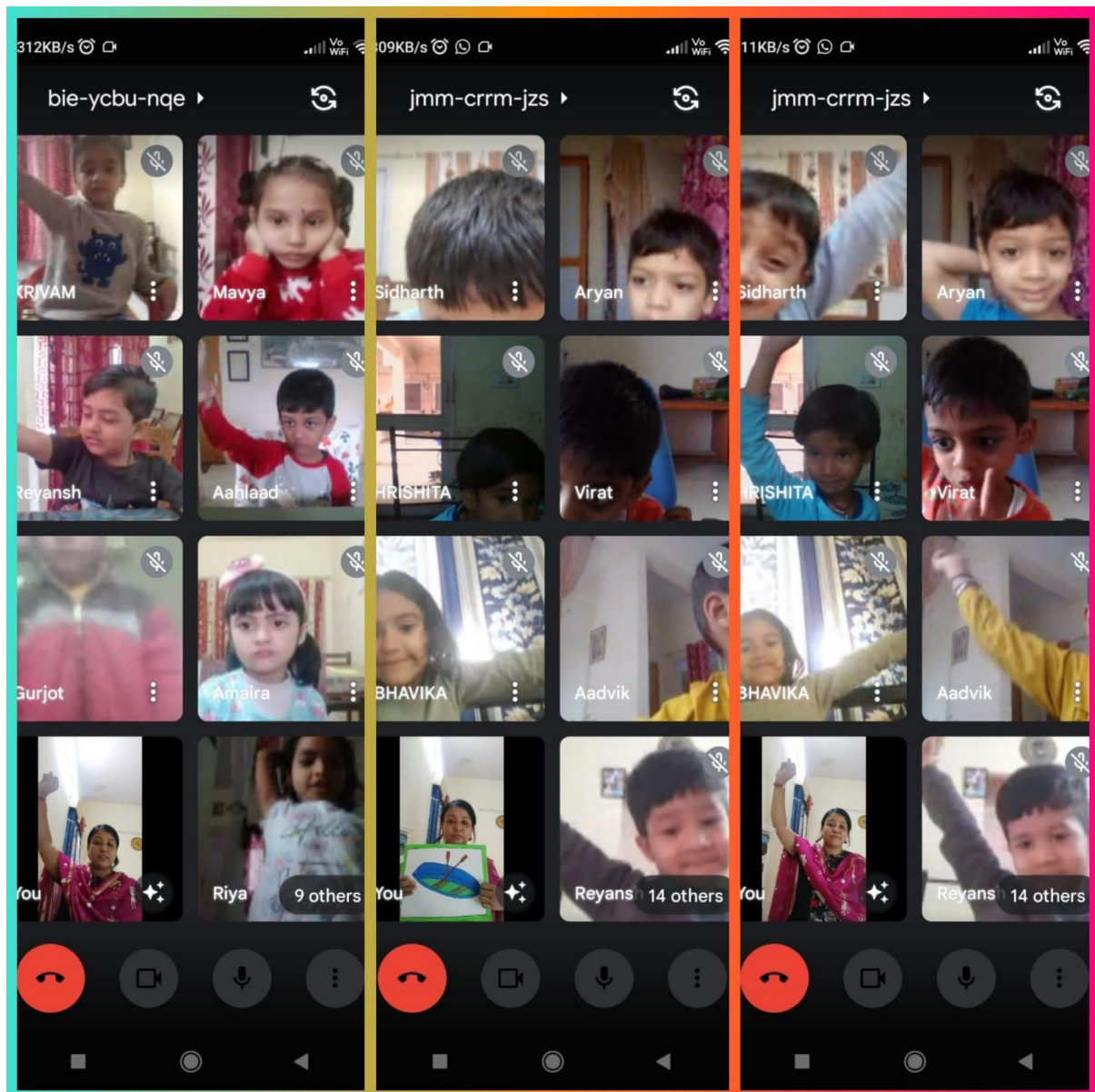
- **CLASS WEBINAR**

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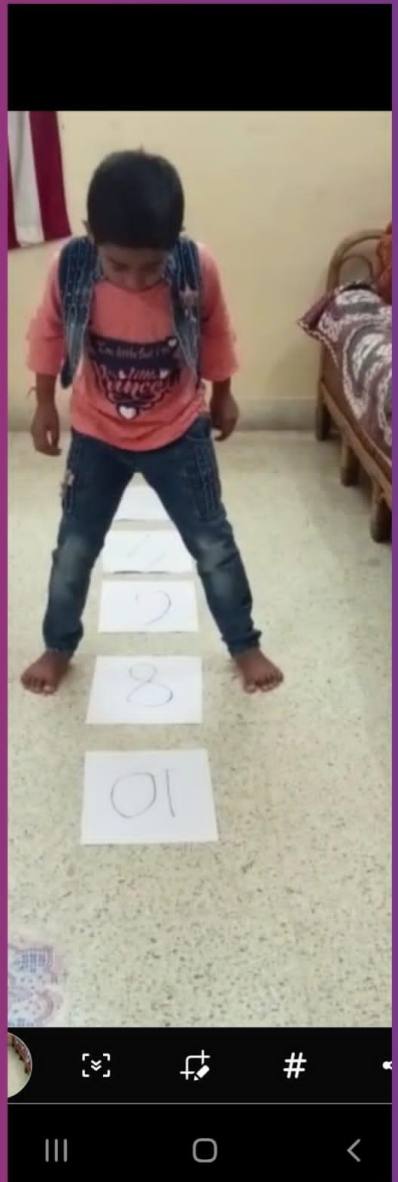
ACTIVITY 3- SKIP COUNTING OF NUMBERS
