
### CONVERSATIONAL SKILLS

# <u>UK</u>G



## • STORY TELLING


# <u>LKG</u>


#### MESSAGE OF THE MONTH


## • <u>CLASS WEBINAR</u>






# **ACTIVITY 2- COTTON SWAB ACTIVITY**
