The Activity teacher-in-charge Mrs Anita Bisht explained and demonstrated the activity in a very simple step by step process to enable children to understand the activity easily and then helped the children individually to do the activity. Children enjoyed making and converting vegetable prints in to beautiful flowers with the help of their respective class teachers and Activity Teacher.

senses. Palm Printing is a sensory activity which improves fine motor skills, strengthens finger and hand muscles and enhances creativity and imagination.



#### 7. GROUP ACTIVITY- TEAR AND PASTE(LKG)

Paper Tearing and Pasting activity was conducted on 12<sup>th</sup> April for LKG classes. It was a structured activity in which children were made to paste the torn paper inside an apple made on a chart paper. Paper pasting activity is a form of art, which encourages fine motor skills, neural development and problem-solving abilities. It is an expression of their creativity. It's a playful and fun method of learning.



#### 8. WORKSHOP ON FIRST AID BY DR DAS

All the teachers attended a workshop on First Aid at Naval Kindergarten NSB on 12<sup>th</sup> April. Dr Das conducted the workshop and told the teachers about the importance of first —aid through a presentation. She further explained how to give first — aid to the students in case there is a medical emergency like students may get injured on the playground or feel sick. She gave

important information regarding handling a bruise, a cut, a burn, a fracture, breathing problem etc. It was a highly informative and useful session.



# 9. INTRODUCTION OF RED COLOUR(LKG)

Children usually learn about colour during their preschool years. Recognising the colours and identifying the colour name is an important part of a child's development. Early identification of colours help to create the cognitive link between visual clues and words. Fine motor skills and the coordination of those little hand muscles, is very important for their self care, such as threading buttons on a shirt and holding a pencil so they can colour or write. Paper Crushing is also done as a warm up exercise for any other activity to be completed. In view of the above Paper crushing and Pasting activity was conducted on 13<sup>th</sup> April for LKG classes to develop their fine motor skills and coordination. Children enjoyed tearing, crushing and pasting small pieces of paper in a ball made on chart. Children were encouraged to do this activity.



# 12. GROUP ACTIVITY - PAPER ROLLING AND PASTING(LKG)

A group activity of Paper Rolling and pasting was conducted on 18th April for LKG children. It was a structured activity in which children were made to roll the papers and thereafter paste them as candles on the cake made on the chart. Paper rolling concentrates on eye-hand coordination, concentration and hand muscle development. It also enhances creativity and brings out a sense of happiness and achievement, as their favourite cake was decorated with candles through this method.



#### 13. SUMMER SEASON

Special morning session on Summer season was conducted for LKG and UKG children during morning assembly on 18<sup>th</sup> April. The children, with the help of props, were told about the summer season, the clothes to be worn, the weather conditions and the types of food eaten etc.





## 14. LEMONADE MAKING ACTIVITY

Lime juice making activity was conducted for LKG and UKG classes on 18<sup>th</sup> April. The teachers showed the children the ingredients and the process of making lime juice. This activity helps in developing the sensory skills.



## 15. INTRODUCTION OF YELLOW COLOUR

Yellow colour was introduced on 19<sup>th</sup> April to LKG children during the morning assembly. The LKG assembly area was decorated with yellow colour theme and teachers were also dressed in yellow. Rhyme related to yellow colour was sung to emphasize the colour concept.
