1. SANDWICH MAKING ACTIVITY

Sandwich making is a great way to practice fine motor skills and foster self confidence in a child. Most importantly, the child will enjoy the feeling of accomplishment. In view of the above, an interactive activity was held for LKG and UKG wings on 4th July. The teacher started off by showing and explaining children about the different ingredients bread, butter and jam to be used. Then she demonstrated the activity in a step-by-step process.

'Healthy eating keeps the heart beating'

Research has shown that healthy eating habits are more likely to stay with you if you learn them as a child. That's why it is important that we teach our children good habits now. It enables children to be physically fit and mentally alert. Keeping this point in mind, a special assembly on healthy food was done for all the class groups of KG, NSB on 11th July. The teacher explained the importance of eating healthy food in a beautiful way. To give a real time experience to children, she showed and explained the different types of food products available in the market, i.e., fruits, vegetables, pulses, dairy and poultry products. During the assembly, with the help of story, role play and props teachers explained the children about the importance of 'Eat healthy and stay healthy'.

5. PAPER FOLDING ACTIVITY (LKG):

Paper folding is a fun activity that helps teachers and parents to interact with children while creating something new and interesting. Apart from this, there are many educational benefits of paper folding activity. It enhances their eye hand co-ordination and fine motor skills too. An Origami activity was conducted for LKG classes on 18th July . Children enjoyed making paper boats.

6.FRUIT CHAAT MAKING(UKG):

Life Skill Activity helps children build self-confidence, encourage critical thinking & foster independence. Fruit Chaat Activity is one of the important Life Skill Activity that teaches children to take care of their health.

7. GERMINATION ACTIVITY (LKG)

On 19th July a Germination activity was done in LKG, parents were being requested to deposit some container or pot, Soil, Water, and some Seeds to the class teacher with the child's name. To explain the activity respective class teachers demonstrated the activity step by step, teacher also explained that plant needs sunlight and water to grow and then children along with the teacher sowed the seeds. All the children used to see their plant every day until the seeds grew into the saplings. The children were really happy to see the plant germinated after a week.

8. IMAGINATION CLAY MODELLING ACTIVITY

Clay modelling has many educational benefits for kids. Clay modelling not only encourages play based learning, but it also helps children to apply creativity and develops their fine motor skills. It also improves eye-hand co-ordination. The second co-curricular activity Clay Modelling Activity was held on 21st July for LKG and on 22nd July for UKG children. The parents were briefed about all the important points regarding the clay modelling activity in advance through a detailed circular. The activity was very well organized and all the children actively participated in the activity. The children enjoyed themselves molding the clay into beautifully crafted objects After receiving the pictures, the best 10 Models were selected by the class teacher and same were sent to the judges to make the final judgement of the winners. 10. STORY TELLING: THE OLD MAN AND HIS SONS

The story of "The Old Man and his Sons" was performed by the teachers for UKG children of NSB wing on 25thJuly by using relevant props. Value education was inculcated among children by telling the moral "United we stand, divided we fall".

11.COLLAGE ACTIVITY - HEALTHY FOOD AND JUNK FOOD
