ACTIVITY REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER 2022

The month of November was filled with lots of fun and frolic. The activities planned in the month, witnessed lot of enthusiasm among the children.

• **FIRE DRILL**

Fire Drill was conducted in Naval Kindergarten, DH wing on 1st November.

This exercise was done to sensitize school staff and children about emergency procedures and actions to be undertaken in event of fire breaking out in the school premises.

Some focal points of the drill were:-

- HM Ma'am educated the school team including teachers, office staff and helpers about individual and collective responsibilities in the Fire Drill.
- Children were cautioned about how they must conduct themselves if a fire broke out.
- Observations of people's actions and any difficulties faced during the Drill were made.
- A roll call (head count) was taken at the muster point.

The Fire Drill was smoothly and successfully completed in 01:14.76 mins.



- **TRAFFIC SIGNAL TAKE AWAY**

As a part of their curriculum, children were taught about various aspects of safety including road safety. The concept of traffic signal and the significance of red, yellow and green lights were introduced to the children in the morning assembly on 3 November 2022. The same was reiterated in class by their teachers using chalk board, smart board, textbooks, etc. The children also recited red light, red light rhyme along with their teachers. In the activity class, children were asked to stick red, yellow and green coloured paper on the black framework of paper traffic signal. This was given to the children as a takeaway to carry back home. An important concept was taught to the children in a playway method and the children thoroughly enjoyed this activity.

A special assembly on Guru Nanak Jayanti was performed on 8th November by LKG -K children with full spirit and they have shown the teachings of Guru Nanak Dev ji....kids thoroughly enjoyed and learned the message.
