# > NAVY DAY CELEBRATION:

Navy day is celebrated to commemorate the courageous attack by the Indian Naval missile ships on Karachi harbour during the Indo-Pakistan war on 4<sup>th</sup> December 1971 as well as a reverence to all the martyrs of the war. Navy day is observed every year to celebrate and recognize the splendor, great achievements and role of the naval force towards safe guarding the maritime interests of the nation.

As part of the Navy day celebrations, special morning was conducted for all the classes during morning assembly on 2<sup>nd</sup>December. A small skit was performed by teachers to give a feel of how Indian Naval Force protects our country. Children were thrilled to watch their teachers performing a short march, dressed in different service uniforms of the Indian Navy. The programme was ended with a patriotic song. Models of ships and submarines were also displayed.

### > VEGETABLE PRINTING - CAPSICUM:

Children acquire a variety of knowledge through painting activities. Painting in early education and care is part of its natural landscape. Painting is a way for children to do many important things: convey ideas, express emotions, use their senses, explore colour, explore process and outcomes, and create aesthetically pleasing works and experiences. Vegetable printing also help in developing fine motor skills.

To enhance creativity among children, a vegetable printing activity was conducted on 5<sup>th</sup> Dec for LKG classes. Children enjoyed making and converting vegetable prints in to beautiful flowers with the help of their respective class teachers and the activity teacher. Children dipped the capsicum in water colour and printed those on a chart paper. Kids also discussed the importance of eating green vegetables for healthy sense organs and happy life. This activity made the children creative and taught them to appreciate the nature for providing us so many valuable things.

#### > STORY TELLING: TWO FRIENDS AND THE BEAR: UKG

Stories play a vital role in the growth and development of children. Stories are also useful for teaching more complex ideas, such as the importance of sharing, the passage of time, compassion for others. Stories help to develop a child's imagination by introducing new ideas into their world – ideas about fantastical worlds, other planets, different points in time and invented characters. It'll encourage the children

to realize that they can, and should, imagine anything they want. Children's stories are important for a number of reasons and form a vital part of the growing process. In view of the above, the story Telling activity was organized for LKG and UKG classes during morning assemblies.

## TWO FRIENDS AND THE BEAR: UKG

The story of "Two Silly Goats" was enacted by the teachers of LKG classes during morning assemblyon 6<sup>th</sup> December by using relevant props to instill the moral "Don't fight, be friends". This is an amazing short **story** about animals with a beautiful **moral** for kids.

### > SPECIAL MORNING: HEALTHY FOOD:

A special assembly was conducted on "Healthy Food" for the children of LKG on 7<sup>th</sup> December. Children were told to eat a healthy diet rich in fruits, vegetables. Whole grains and low–fat dairy to reduce risk of any disease and provide enough calories to lead a healthy life. Cut outs of different fruits, vegetables etc. were shown to the children to reinforce healthy eating.

# > Special Morning: Winter Season - LKG & UKG

Special morning session on winter season was conducted for LKG and UKG children during morning assembly on 19<sup>th</sup> December. The children, with the help of props, were told about the winter season, the clothes to be worn, the weather conditions and the types of food eaten etc. Teacher explained the characteristics of winter season to children with various examples on the basis of food we eat, clothes we wear and things we do. Children were also taught lines about Public Speaking on Winter season. To make it a fun activity, teachers themselves wore winter clothes and children were encouraged to do the same. Mufflers, caps and sweaters were worn which made the activity a lot of fun.

#### COLLAGE MAKING ACTIVITY: LKG(Wild Animals and Domestic Animals)

Collage is a simple craft activity that involves pasting items like cutouts of papers or pictures onto a sheet of paper. The activity not only helps children develop their

eye-hand coordination & build fine motor skills but it also encourages children to learn specific topics in a fun way. With the objective to teach children about animals and help them identify the similarities & differences among wild and domestic animals a collage making activity on Wild & domestic animals was conducted for all the LKG classes of NKG NSB on 19<sup>th</sup>December. The class teachers started with a short presentation where they illustrated various Wild and Domestic animals. Children were explained about the difference between the two categories and the place where they live, and later on all the children stick the pictures on the chart. It was a fun way of teaching the children about domestic and wild animals including their habitats.

# > ROLE PLAY ON "HELPERS" BY UKG CHILDREN

Conversation skills role play was conducted for UKG classes during morning assembly on 20<sup>th</sup> December. The topic was "Helpers".
