1. NAVY DAY CELEBRATIONS



Navy day is celebrated to commemorate the courageous attack by the Indian Naval missile ships on Karachi harbour during the Indo-Pakistan war on 4th December 1971 as well as a reverence to all the martyrs of the war. Navy day is observed every year to celebrate and recognise the splendour, great achievements and role of the naval force towards safe guarding the maritime interests of the nation.

Navy Day was celebrated at NKG NSB on 1st December 2023. As part of the celebrations serving parents of students were invited to the school and Mrs Rashmeet Minhas, Headmistress NKG NSB welcomed them. Thereafter the parents Cdr Puneet Pal, Surg Lt Cdr Raviraj, Abhishek Kumar EAR 3 and Partho Das MCERA II shared their experiences and also explained them about the importance of Navy Day to the children.

Children too participated in the event wherein they dressed up in Naval attire and confidently spoke about Navy.

The event culminated with the Headmistress thanking the parents for sparing their valuable time and sharing their experiences.

2. VEGETABLE PRINTING ACTIVITY



Children acquire a variety of knowledge through painting activities. Painting in early education and care is part of its natural landscape. Painting is a way for children to do many important things: convey ideas, express emotion, use their senses, explore colour, explore process and outcomes, and create aesthetically pleasing works and experiences. Vegetable printing also help in developing fine motor skills.

To enhance creativity among children, a vegetable printing activity was conducted on 8th December 2023 for LKG classes. Children enjoyed making and converting vegetable prints in to beautiful flowers with the help of the Activity Teachers, Mrs. Pooja Singh and the activity teacher. Children dipped the capsicum in water colour and printed those on a chart paper. Kids also discussed the importance of eating green vegetables for healthy sense organs and happy life. This activity made the children creative and taught them to appreciate the nature for providing us so many valuable things.

3. WINTER SEASON SPECIAL ASSEMBLY



Special morning session on winter season was conducted for LKG and UKG children during morning assembly on 12th December 2023. The children, with the help of props, were told about the winter season, the clothes to be worn, the weather conditions and the types of food eaten etc. Teacher explained the characteristics of winter season to children with various examples on the basis of food we eat, clothes we wear and things we do. Children were also taught lines about Public Speaking on Winter season. To make it a fun activity, teachers themselves wore winter clothes and children were encouraged to do the same. Mufflers, caps and sweaters were worn which made the activity a lot of fun.

4. GROUP ACTIVITY- COLLAGE OF ANIMALS



Collage is a simple craft activity that involves pasting items like cutouts of papers or pictures onto a sheet of paper. The activity not only helps children develop their eye-hand coordination & build fine motor skills but it also encourages children to learn specific topics in a fun way. With the objective to teach children about animals and help them identify the similarities & differences among wild and domestic animals a collage making activity on Wild, Aquatic & domestic animals was conducted for all the LKG classes of NKG NSB on 14th December 2023. The class teachers started with a short presentation where they illustrated various Wild, Aquatic and Domestic animals. Children were explained about the difference between the two categories and the place where they live, and later on all the children stick the pictures on the chart. It was a fun way of teaching the children about domestic and wild animals including their habitats.

5. ORAL HEALTH CHECKUP CAMP



Oral hygiene is one of the main concerns of every parent and to educate the kindergarteners on the importance of maintaining Oral

Hygiene, a Dental Check-Up Camp was organised for UKG students on 12th December 2023 at NKG NSB.

Under the aegis of INHS Kalyani the camp was inaugurated by Surg Cmde Rohit Sharma, Commanding Officer INHS Kalyani in the presence of Commodore Vikrant Kishore (Vice Chairman NCS), Cdr Manorma, Dr. Parul Kumar, Principal, Navy Children School, Visakhapatnam and Mrs Rashmeet Minhas, Headmistress Naval Kindergarten, Nausenabaugh. Through a presentation the children were educated on the importance of taking care of their teeth by brushing in the correct manner and preventing cavities by avoiding chocolates.

Subsequently the dental check up was undertaken in the assembly shed in the presence of respective class teachers. A dental card was also filled for parent's reference.

The event concluded with the handing over of gifts to children. The VIP was thereafter seen off by Mrs Rashmeet Minhas, Headmistress NKG NSB.
