ACTIVITY REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY 2024

The year progressed further as we neared towards the fruition of our academic session. Children enjoyed each and every activity and events to the core.

- **PICTURE TALK**

An activity on picture talk – ‘Grandparents’ was conducted in the morning assembly on 2nd February. Teacher had shown pictures of grandfather and grandmother and explained how they take care of them. This activity develops the language and social skills of children.



- **GERMINATION OF SEED**

Germination Activity was conducted on 15th February. Students were asked to get small earthen pots with mud and some mustard seeds for this activity. Children were taught about various types of plants and conditions essential for their growth. They were explained about the step by step process of germination and how root and shoot develop from a seed and grow into a plant. Children experienced and learned how to sow seeds and water their pots, while singing "sow the seeds now" song. They were delighted to see their plants grow. All children participated in this activity with great enthusiasm. This activity helped in strengthening fine and gross motor skills of students. It also taught children how to grow plants and nurture our environment.



- **CO CURRICULAR ACTIVITY**

As a part of Co-Curricular Activities, Fancy Dress Activity was conducted on 12th February for LKG and on 13th February UKG and Talent Hunt Activity was conducted on 26th February for LKG and 27th February for UKG. Co-curricular activities play a vital role in the personality development of children and teach them important life skills such as teamwork, communication skills, build their confidence and bring out their leadership qualities. Both LKG and UKG students participated in these activities with great enthusiasm.





- **PAPER FOLDING ACTIVITY**

This activity was undertaken during online class on 22nd February. Teacher explained the activity by folding a square paper and asked the children to paste in the scrap book and complete by drawing a doll with the help of different shapes. Children thoroughly enjoyed the activity.



- **ONLINE CLASS**

View unavailability of school buses due to International City Parade 20th, 22nd February, online classes were conducted through webinar. Topics from the daily split up including activities and rhymes were covered in the webinar. It gave children the experience of class room during online studies.



- **CARE FOR NATURE**

Planters with plants of different varieties are hung up outside each class to bring an aesthetic sense to the school corridors. Children are encouraged to water the plants to highlight the importance of caring for the nature and maintain the surroundings beautiful.



- **SHRAMDAAN**

Shramdaan means a voluntary contribution by the person towards community welfare by physical effort. In order to inculcate the value in the present generation, Shramdaan is organized every day at Naval Kindergarten, Dolphin Hill. As a part of Shramdaan, one child from each class is nominated every day to put the classroom dustbin in the main dustbin. It also includes cleaning of the class rooms by the students before they leave. The aim is to help children understand the dignity of labour and the sense of responsibility towards keeping the environment clean.



- **CONVERSATIONAL SKILLS**

LKG

On February 21st, conversation skills activity was conducted, focusing on teaching children the etiquettes of telephone conversations. This activity not only enhances confidence but also instills basic telephonic conversation manners. For LKG children, this aids in skill development, fostering effective communication from an early age.



UKG

Conversation skill on the topic 'Picnic at the Beach' was conducted in Assembly. Conversation skills are important for child's development and wellbeing. It helps children to have good communication skills and express themselves in a better way. Children thoroughly enjoyed the small skit performed by their friends who told them how to enjoy on beach with family and friends.



- **PUBLIC SPEAKING**

Public speaking on the topic birthday party was done in assembly. The teacher explained about importance of birthday celebration and encouraged children to share their thoughts on the special day. The children were reminded about how they celebrate the birthday by inviting their friends and relatives. Through this we help them to develop their vocabulary and get better at pronunciations and enhance their critical thinking and create self-awareness in them.



UKG
