### > GROUP ACTIVITY: LANTERN MAKING :LKG AND UKG

By participating in a group activity, children learn from each other and function as each other's role models. They also learn how to be part of a team and therefore develop social skills. Teamwork promotes problem-solving to achieve a common goal. Keeping in mind the same, a structured group activity was conducted on 18<sup>th</sup> October for LKG and UKG children on lantern making in view of upcoming Diwali festival. All the tiny tots participated enthusiastically under the guidance of Activity teachers.

# > STORY TELLING: THE HARE AND THE TORTOISE: LKG

The enchanting marvel of storytelling inspires kids and helps them relish a magical world. The importance of storytelling for children is immense. Every captivating tale brings new ideas to their imagination. Storytelling is no less than art. It is used to share wisdom across ages and communicate the essence of life.

The story of "The Hare and the Tortoise" was enacted by the teachers of LKG on 19<sup>th</sup>October by using relevant props. The hare and tortoise story is one of the most popular moral stories that is taught to children. ## > STORY TELLING: THE ANT AND THE GRASSHOPPER: UKG
